Renter Checklist

COVID19- Rental Assistance- Applications are now open for those with Past Rent Due

If you meet all of the follow, you are invited to apply now for rental/utility assistance.

- Are you a renter living in Minnesota?
- Are you qualified for unemployment insurance? OR, Have you been negatively impacted by COVID-19 in any way?
- Do you have past rent due?
- Do you know the annual income of all adults in your household.
- To be eligible you must meet80% AMI [Hennepin county: 4-person HH- \$79,900] AMI chart by county

Tips:

- Review the <u>Renter Checklist</u> to learn about the materials you will need for your application and apply now.
- Applications are not reviewed until all materials are submitted.
- When you apply for assistance for past rent due, you can also ask for up to 3 months of future rent payment assistance.
- Eligible costs include: rent, manufactured home lot rent, rental of a manufactured home, utilities

Landlord Checklist

Households who are current on their rent payments and need help with future rent will be able to apply later in phase 2. Look for updates at renthelpmn.org and social media.

including electric, gas, power, heat, water, sewer, bulk fuel, eviction costs, fees charged by your landlord, hotel costs if the hotel is your residence, and other costs related to keeping you in your home.

Landlords:

- If you have renters with past rent due, review the <u>Landlord checklist</u> and <u>register now</u>.
- Talk with you tenants and provide documents they are missing for their applications.
- Let renters know they can also ask for up to 3 months of future rent payments.
- Register and send in your documents so you can accept the direct payments.

MN Cold Weather Rule Ended April 15

Energy Assistance Program (Renters & Homeowners)

If you need help paying your energy bills and want to prevent a shut off.....

The Energy Assistance Program can help you pay energy costs-- such as a heating bill-- between Oct 1 and May 30 each year. If you qualify, you could receive a grant to cover some of your energy expenses. This grant is paid directly to your energy provider, to reduce your energy bill.

Renters and home owners may be eligible. If you live in Hennepin County, Community Action Partnership of Hennepin County can assist you with your application.
