### YMCA DAY CAMP GATHERING PINES (Kici Yapi) Camp Scholarship for Edina Students

**Applications accepted <u>Jan. 17 - Jan. 30</u>** on a first-come, first served based or until spots are filled, whichever comes first.

YMCA Day Camp Gathering Pines (formally Kici Yapi) is located in Lakeville, MN. A bus from Edina will bring the campers to and from camp each day. Campers explore hiking through wooded trails, studying the wonders of nature, canoeing along lakeshores, building character through teamwork, and conquering many challenges under the leadership of well-trained staff. Exciting activities include archery, swimming, nature studies, canoeing, fort building, gaga ball, camp crafts, cookouts and group games! Specialty Camps Provide two hours of focus on a favorite activity. Bring a bag lunch and 2 snacks daily to camp.

#### **Elementary Students**

Current Edina K-5 students may apply for a one-week traditional camp experience. Family fee: \$25

#### Middle School Students

**New:** current 6th-7th-8th graders have a variety of teen camp options to choose from including Leaders In Training (2 week camp), or one-week Archery, Artist, Canoe/Kayak, Green Team, Survival Skills, Climbing and fishing. Spots very limited. family fee ranges:\$25-\$50 depending on the camp selected
